Proposed 2024-2025 MAWSAC-TAC Work Plan

Background

The Metropolitan Area Water Supply Advisory Committee (MAWSAC) is responsible for assisting the Council in its water supply planning work. MAWSAC's work will be supported by the Technical Advisory Committee (TAC).

The Metropolitan Council is in the process of updating regional policies and plans, which will then shape the update of local comprehensive plans. In 2024, MAWSAC (with TAC input) has a critical role in approving the Metro Area Water Supply Plan, which is a piece of the regional Water Policy Plan. In 2025, MAWSAC and TAC will provide important guidance about local planning assistance for water supply planning – outreach, planning tools, and implementation resources needed for plan implementation.

The Council plans to hold meetings in person. Proposed committee meeting schedule and outcomes for 2024 and 2025:

- January 9, 2024: Joint MAWSAC-TAC meeting for year-end evaluation and 2024-2025 work plan. Input on water sustainability projects of interest for 2024-2025, with emphasis on what is needed in advance of the MWSP.
- **February 29, 2024**: Workshop to review and revise the draft MWSP based on stakeholder input. Provide feedback on WPP content.
- **Spring 2024**: Final input on MWSP before public comment period. Begin discussing information and tools needed to support local planning efforts.
- **Summer 2024**: Approve the release of the draft MWSP with the WPP for public review. Continue discussing tools that may be useful for local planning efforts.
- **Fall 2024**: Approve MWSP (revised based on public comments) and support Council adoption of WPP. Prepare launch of new tools. May include additional joint meeting.
- Winter 2025: Joint MAWSAC-TAC meeting for year-end evaluation and 2025-2026 work plan.
- **Spring 2025**: Support development of information and tools to support local planning efforts, such as early input on water supply content in Council system statements.
- Summer 2025: Continue supporting development of information and tools to support local

planning efforts.

- **Fall 2025**: Continue supporting development of information and tools to support local planning efforts, including outreach about water supply content in Council system statements and the Planlt program.
- Winter 2026: Joint MAWSAC-TAC meeting for year-end evaluation and 2026-2027 work plan.

2024-2025 Work Plan Goals

At the end of 2024, the committees will have shaped and approved an updated Metro Area Water Supply Plan. This plan will guide state, regional, and local resources toward their shared water supply goals.

At the end of 2025, the committees will have influenced information and tools to support the implementation of regional water supply plans and support local plan updates and implementation.

The MAWSAC/TAC work plan supports the Council's long-range water supply planning function. In general, the decadal planning cycle includes these phases:

- Year 0-2: Technical analysis and engagement
- Year 2-4: Policy research and development
- Year 5: Regional plan adoption and outreach
- Year 6-8: Local assistance
- Year 9: Plan review and analysis



Committee work will be shaped by input from subregional water supply work groups and build on the recommendations and information in their February 2022 report to the Metropolitan Council and MN Legislature: (<u>https://metrocouncil.org/Wastewater-Water/Publications-And-Resources/WATER-SUPPLY-PLANNING/REPORTS-TO-THE-LEGISLATURE/2022-MAWSAC-Recommendations-for-Water-Supply-Plann.aspx</u>).

Roles and Expectations

• **Committee chairs** support committee goals and outcomes by guiding work plan development, leading meetings to achieve outcomes, and encouraging member participation.

• Committee members

- Review materials that are sent out beforehand. *Council staff will strive to send materials a week in advance.*
- Participate in the meetings based on experience and knowledge, they share guidance and information with fellow members and Council staff to incorporate into draft reports, support letters to legislators or agencies, and/or project scoping, as appropriate. Council staff will try to design meetings in ways to allow contribution in multiple ways for different communication/learning styles.
- **Council staff** draft meeting materials based on work plan and committee chair guidance, provide administrative support and facilitation during meetings, help to implement relevant committee recommendations, and share information as requested.

2024-2025 Meeting Schedule & Topics

The timing and topics may shift as needed. Committee chairs may modify the work plan when approving agendas. As opportunities for meetings on emerging water supply issues arise, staff may reach out and invite interested committee members to advise on issues as appropriate.

The proposed meeting schedule is based on committee member input in January 2024. Most prefer to meet on Wednesday afternoons during the first or second week of the month; meeting over the lunch hour is an option. Annual or semi-annual joint meetings of MAWSAC and TAC are preferred.

Joint meetings in the Spring and Fall of 2024 have been included to accommodate the formal public review process and adoption schedule for the Regional Development Guide and related Water Resources Policy Plan. The 2024-2025 work plan may be revised based on direction from committee chairs and from committee member input.
