

# **Mahtomedi Interceptor Improvements Project**

## **Metropolitan Council Environmental Services Project No. 805530**

### **Project Description**

Metropolitan Council Environmental Services (MCES), operator of the metro-area wastewater collection and treatment system, is making improvements to its regional sanitary sewer facilities that serve the Mahtomedi area.

Construction of the sewer improvements began in July 2013. Construction detours and temporary road closures will be posted. Most of the construction is scheduled for completion in 2013, with final restoration of streets, trails and landscape to be completed by July 2014.

The sewer improvements include:

- Upgrading MCES's pumping station, located at the northwest corner of the intersection of Lincolntown Ave. and Robert Street/Old Wildwood Road.
- Installing a dual force main interceptor sewer beginning at the pumping station and going generally south along the east side of Lincolntown Ave., and then west along the south side of Long Lake Road where it will connect to an existing regional sewer along Century Ave. south of Long Lake Road.
- Repairing a regional sewer located at the intersection of Birchwood Road and Wildwood Beach Road.

The sewer improvements are needed to maintain reliability and to increase the level of service of the facilities. MCES originally introduced plans for the sewer improvements during a public information meeting on January 12, 2010, in Mahtomedi and a public hearing on January 26, 2010, in St. Paul.
