Station Overview: MCES has supported water quality monitoring of the Beltline Interceptor since 1995. The monitoring station is located in St. Paul, Minnesota, 2.2 miles upstream from the interceptor discharge to the Mississippi River. Major improvements were made to the monitoring station during the 2001 monitoring season.

As a result, very little monitoring data are available for 2001, and 2001 data for the station are not included in this report. The station improvements, which included re-location of all the monitoring equipment to an above-ground shelter, were completed in late 2001, so that the Beltline Interceptor monitoring station was again functional in 2002.
