Major Impacts

Robert Street will close from Kellogg Boulevard to Fifth Street beginning the week of Oct. 5, not Sept. 28 as previously announced. Fourth Street between Minnesota and Jackson streets will close beginning the week of Oct. 5.

Fourth Street

Starting week of Sept. 28

- Fourth will close about 100 feet west of Minnesota. Access to Capital City Parking Ramp and the parking lot on the northwest corner of Minnesota and Fourth will be maintained from Cedar on Fourth. But drivers will be unable to continue to Minnesota on Fourth heading east.

Continuing week of Sept. 28

- Fourth Street is closed to all traffic between Minnesota and Robert streets
- Sidewalks are open, but crosswalk access is reduced
- Loading zone on north side of Fourth relocated to east side of Minnesota north of Fourth

Starting week of Oct. 5

- Fourth between Minnesota and Jackson will close
- Sidewalks at the corner of Fourth and Robert will close

Minnesota Street

Continuing week of Sept. 28

- Sidewalks remain open, but two crosswalks remain temporarily closed at Minnesota & Fourth
- Two lanes remain open to local traffic only from Kellogg Boulevard to Fourth to retain access to the student drop-off area at the corner of Minnesota and Kellogg
- Stops for Metro Transit bus routes 16, 50 and 94 remain relocated from the corner of Minnesota and Fourth to the corner of Minnesota and Sixth
- Access maintained for Capital City Parking Ramp & Kellogg Square loading dock via Kellogg
- No on-street parking continues from Kellogg to Fifth

Starting week of Oct. 5

- All but one of Minnesota's one-way northbound lanes will be reopened. The easternmost lane will remain closed from Kellogg to Fifth

Robert Street

Continuing week of Sept. 28

- Sidewalks remain open with limited crosswalk access at Fourth
- The bus stop for Route 71 remains relocated from the corner of Minnesota and Fourth to the corner of Robert and Sixth
- Robert remains reduced to one lane each way at intersection of Fourth

Starting week of Oct. 5

- Robert will be closed from Kellogg to Fifth. Northbound traffic will be detoured to Minnesota. Southbound traffic will be detoured to Jackson

Jackson Street

Continuing week of Sept. 28

- Two of the four traffic lanes remain closed at the intersection with Fourth
- Sidewalks remain open

Please don't talk to crews or go around barriers into construction zones. Construction hours will generally be from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m. weekdays, but crews will be allowed to work from 7 a.m. to 10 p.m. seven days a week if needed. *Schedules are subject to changes due to weather and other unforeseen circumstances! Check www.centralcorridor.org frequently for updates.*
