

Central Corridor Light Rail Transit

Construction Update

Oct. 9, 2009



Crews closed the intersection of Fourth and Robert streets in downtown St. Paul and began removing the road surface so they can start relocating public utilities this fall in advance of LRT construction in late summer 2010.

Major Impacts

Robert Street from Kellogg Boulevard to Fifth Street and Fourth Street between Minnesota and Jackson streets remain closed the week of Oct. 12.

Fourth Street

Starting week of Oct. 12

- Pedestrian crossing at Robert closes

Continuing week of Oct. 12

- Fourth Street remains closed from Minnesota to Jackson streets
- Pedestrians will still have limited crossings at Minnesota
- Loading zone on north side of Fourth remains relocated to east side of Minnesota north of Fourth

Minnesota Street

Continuing week of Oct. 12

- Three lanes remain open to through traffic from Kellogg to Fifth
- Sidewalks remain open, but one crosswalk remains temporarily closed at Minnesota & Fourth
- Stops for Metro Transit bus routes 16, 50 and 94 remain relocated from the corner of Minnesota and Fourth to the corner of Minnesota and Sixth
- Access maintained for Capital City Parking Ramp & Kellogg Square loading dock via Kellogg
- No on-street parking continues from Kellogg to Fifth

Robert Street

Starting week of Oct. 12

- Pedestrian crossing at Fourth closes

Continuing week of Oct. 12

- Robert remains closed from Kellogg to Fifth. Northbound traffic remains detoured to Minnesota. Southbound traffic remains detoured to Jackson
- Robert remains reduced to two lanes between Fifth and Sixth
- Crosswalk on south side of Sixth crossing Robert remains closed
- Bus stop heading south remains relocated to the north on west side of Robert between Sixth and Seventh
- Sidewalks remain open
- The bus stop for Route 71 remains relocated from the corner of Minnesota and Fourth to the corner of Robert and Sixth
- Bus stop on Sixth and Robert heading northbound remains where it is
- Access remains open to First National Bank's loading dock
- Kellogg Square's pick-up and drop-off zone remains open

Jackson Street

Continuing week of Oct. 12

- Two of the four traffic lanes remain closed at the intersection with Fourth
- Sidewalks remain open

Please don't talk to crews or go around barriers into construction zones. Construction hours will generally be from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m. weekdays, but crews will be allowed to work from 7 a.m. to 10 p.m. seven days a week if needed. **Schedules are subject to changes due to weather and other unforeseen circumstances!
