UPCOMING WORK

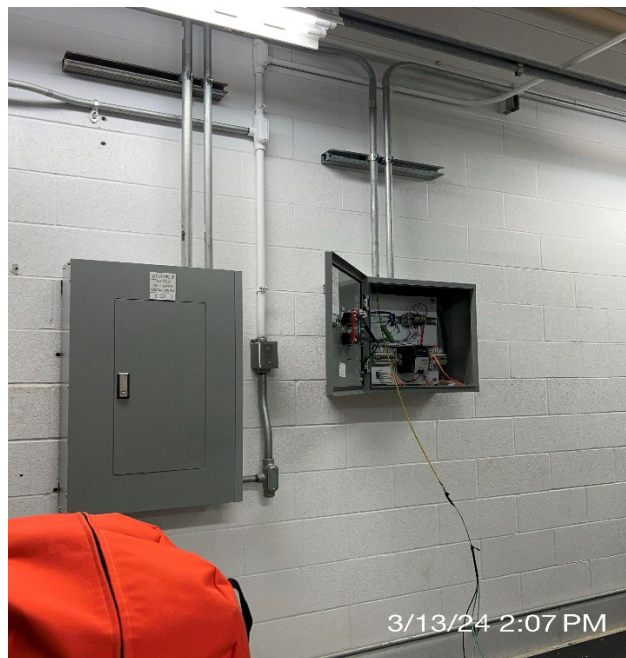
- ADA signage improvements on the Operations Building and Administration Building, removal of regulator on natural gas line in the Sludge Pumping Building.

- Summer 2024
