### About this project

Metropolitan Council Environmental Services (MCES), operator of the metro-area wastewater collection and treatment system, is making improvements to aging and deteriorating regional sanitary sewer facilities that serve homes and businesses near the Bass Lake Road and Vagabond Lane intersection in Maple Grove (see map to the right). The work includes two phases of regional sanitary sewer pipe rehabilitation.

### Progress update – Phase 1

Crews restored the Phase 1 construction area last fall. They will return this spring to evaluate the condition of the restored area and complete the restoration process, as necessary.

### Progress update – Phase 2

The Phase 2 construction area moved from the planning to design stage over the winter. Project design will last through 2023 and construction is expected to begin in 2024.
